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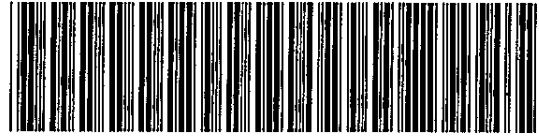

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SEKHARAN FAMILY CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation not for profit in compliance with Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, does hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Corporation shall be Sekharan Family Charitable Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principle Office

The principal place of business in Florida and the mailing address of the Corporation is 16140 Rio Rodeo Dr., Delray Beach, Florida 33446.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are exclusively for charitable, benevolent, eleemosynary and educational purposes,, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or corresponding provisions of any future United States internal revenue law) (the "Code"), including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3). In furtherance of these purposes, the Corporation may provide scholarships to underprivileged individuals pursuing post-secondary education in the field of pre-medicine or medicine.

Furthermore, the Corporation is formed exclusively for purposes for which a corporation may be formed under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, and not for pecuniary profit or financial gain. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers or other private persons or organizations, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. The Corporation shall have the power to do any and all lawful acts and things and to engage in any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, suitable, desirable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment or attainment of any or all of the purposes for which the Corporation is organized, and to aid or assist other organizations whose activities are such as to further, accomplish, foster or attain any such purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except to the extent provided in Code Section 501(h)), and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described in Code Section 501(c)(3); or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Code Sections 170(c), 2055(a) and 2522(a). During any period, the Corporation is a "private foundation" as defined in Code Section 509(a), F.S. §617.0335 shall apply.

ARTICLE IV

Manner of Election of Directors

Each Director designated herein shall be deemed to be elected as such as of the time of filing the Articles of Incorporation to serve until his or her replacement is elected at the first annual meeting of the Board of Directors. The Directors elected as set forth herein shall serve for terms of three (3) years each. Directors may be reelected. At the end of each term, a vacancy will be created until a successor is elected.

The election of Directors shall be made at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors, or if action is not then taken, or if there is a vacancy, the election may be made at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors for which notice is given as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The Directors elected as set forth therein shall be elected by the then serving Directors.

ARTICLE V

Initial Directors

Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Judicial Circuit of Florida of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes, or to one or more organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes, as said Court shall determine to best accomplish the exempt purposes of the Corporation.
