KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned incorporators have this day of day o

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of said not for profit corporation shall be "Boca Raton Elks Lodge, No. 2166, Inc., Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America."

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office for the transaction of business of the corporation is to be located in the County of Palm Beach, State of Florida, at 1395 North Federal Highway, Boca Raton, Florida, 33432.

ARTICLE III - EFFECTIVE DATE

The corporation shall be effective on the date these Articles are filed and shall continue is perpetuity.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE(S)
