#### Article III which read:

### "ARTICLE III - PURPOSE ...

The purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be (a) for educational and scientific purposes allowed under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding Section of any future Federal Tax Code; (b) the advancement of science and education by the following functions:

- 1. Organization and management of the International Society for Environmental Bioindicators:
- 2. Editorial management of the Society's peer-reviewed scientific journal, Environmental Bioindicators;
- 3. U.S. coordination of annual society conferences.
- 4. Development and presentation of courses related to environmental bioindicators.
- 5. Promotion and performance of EBI-related research.
- (c) to transact any and all other business allowed by Florida Law in connection therewith; and (d) when necessary, to hold, sell and convey real property by deed or otherwise. No part of the earnings shall inure to a private shareholder or individual."

#### is hereby deleted and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

#### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be also for the advancement of science and education by the following functions:

- 1. Organization and management of the International Society for Environmental Bioindicators;
- 2. Editorial management of the Society's peer-reviewed scientific journal, Environmental Bioindicators:
- 3. U.S. coordination of annual society conferences.
- 4. Development and presentation of courses related to environmental bioindicators.
- 5. Promotion and performance of EBI-related research.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal

Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductable under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporations is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
