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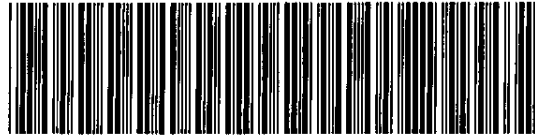

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The affairs of the corportation shall be managed by the board of deacons,such management to be subject to the approval of the church and said board to be composed of not less than five nor more than fifteen and said board of deacons shall be elected from and by the membership of the corporation.the term of service for the deacons shall be for life.

We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together
for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the Laws of the State
of Florida, applicable to corporations not for profit, under the follow-
ing proposed Charter:

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be "Westside Baptist Church
in Wewahitchka, Florida, Inc.," and it is to be located in the City of
Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida.

ARTICLE II - OBJECT

Believing in the Bible as the inspired word of God and as
the sole authority for faith and practice, and acknowledging adherence
to the teachings of Jesus Christ, the general nature of the object of
the corporation shall be: To maintain regular services; to proclaim
earnestly the gospel message and urge its personal acceptance; to
cooperate heartily by prayer, gift and service, in the effort to estab-
lish the Kingdom of Christ throughout the world; to promote systematic
Bible study and training for Christian service and to encourage in
every possible way life enlistment in some form of christian religious
activity; to urge the membership of the corporation to live daily according
to the principles set forth in the Scriptures; to conduct for christian
religious worship and instruction, churches, schools, pastoriums, and
other institutions connected therewith of a religious, educational,
charitable and benevolent character to the end that its own members and
others may be generally instructed and guided concerning those articles of
faith which are most surely held among on Baptist Churches, and to
advance spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and personal purity
among its own membership and the people of the community in which it is
located; to promote home and foreign missions; also to educate and prepare

Christian men and women for the ministry of the gospel of Jesus Christ and ordain such as are approved by the Church.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Every person who believes in repentance toward God, and faith in Jesus Christ, as Saviour and Lord, and who is willing to confess Him publicly as Lord and King and follow Him in baptism by immersion, and to observe the ordinances of Christ and to be governed by His Laws, is qualified and eligible for membership in this corporation. The manner of admission to membership in said corporation shall be as follows: Any person publicly professing faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, giving evidence of a changed heart, and having accepted the aims and ideals of the church as expressed in the Church Covenant, upon a favorable majority vote of the membership of the corporation present at any meeting of said church, shall be accepted as a candidate for baptism and after that into full fellowship of the church; members from other missionary Baptist Churches of like faith and order may be received into membership upon the promise of a letter and upon a favorable vote of the membership of the corporation present at any meeting of the church, but baptism shall be required of those received from other faiths; any person who has been baptised into the fellowship of a missionary Baptist Church, upon giving evidence that the Church involved has disbanded or that its records have been destroyed, may be received into membership upon his or her statement and upon a favorable majority vote of the membership of the corporation present at any meeting of the church, and any person who was once a member of a missionary Baptist Church, but who is now a member of another denomination, may be admitted to membership by statement, upon giving evidence of having been a member of a missionary Baptist Church and upon a favorable majority vote of the membership of the corporation

authorized by law. All elections to membership on said Board of Deacons shall be by majority vote of the members of the corporation present at any business meeting thereof.

The present Board of Deacons of the Westside Baptist Church in Wewahitchka, whose names are set forth hereinafter in Article VII shall constitute the Board of Deacons and shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified.

In addition to said Board of Deacons, the corporation shall have a pastor, church Secretary-Clerk treasurer, Sunday School superintendent, training union director, W. M. U. Director, brotherhood Director, Outreach Director and such other officers as may be necessary, and such officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the corporation present at any business meeting of the corporation for such term as the corporation may provide by its by-laws, except that the pastor shall be called by the membership of the corporation and shall be elected for an indefinite period, and except that two-thirds of the members present at any business meeting of this corporation shall be required to call the pastor or request his resignation.

ARTICLE VIII-BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of the corporation are to be altered or rescinded upon a two-thirds vote of the members present at any regular business meeting of the corporation provided that announcement of said alterations is made in accordance with the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX - INDEBTEDNESS

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself, which shall never be greater than two-thirds of the value of the property of the corporation, shall be Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

ARTICLE X - VALUE OF REAL ESTATE

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold, subject always to the approval of the Circuit Judge, shall be Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00).
