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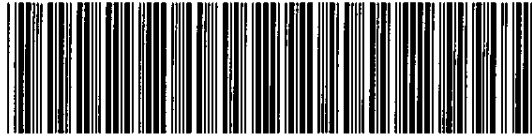

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME.

The name of this corporation shall be: Angels for Mother Earth Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE.

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 5000 12th Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32966.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE(S)

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is(are): To educate people about animals welfare. To raise funds for animals rescue, to assist in spay and neuter programs; to acquire urban lands for animals habitats and save green space for mankind.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is: appointed through an annual meeting.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL DIRECTORS AND/OR OFFICERS

ARTICLE VII. INCORPORATORS.

ARTICLE VIII.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501©)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

ARTICLE IX

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried out on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

ARTICLE X

Upon dissolution of this corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for public purposes.
