("Corporation"), at a special meeting duly convened on December 12, 2016, a quorum being present at all times, having considered the advisability of voluntarily dissolving the Corporation, and it being the unanimous opinion of the Board that dissolution is advisable and in the best interests of the Corporation, and the Board having adopted, by unanimous vote, a plan for a voluntary dissolution of the Corporation, does hereby recommend to its sole member for approval that the Corporation be dissolved in accordance with the following plan:

- 1. Upon resolution of the Board of Directors adopting this plan of dissolution, the Board shall submit the plan to its sole member for approval.
