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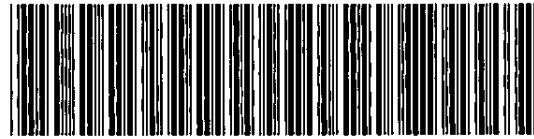

Articles of Incorporations
Of
20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc.

Articles of Incorporations of the undersigned, of which all are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Nonprofit Corporation under the Laws of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article 1: The name shall be: 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc.

Article 2: The Place in Florida where the principle office of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. is to be initially located is the City of Tallahassee, Florida.

Article 3: 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, health and other activities based on uplifting the Central Florida Community. Including for such purpose, the making of distribution to organization that qualify as exempt organizations and/or are classified as 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code. The specific purpose of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida is to:

Host an Annual Community Health Fair, provide tutorial assistant to students in neighboring schools Kindergarten through College, shall host business summits to help individuals start up their own business, shall host a annual community recognition banquet, shall sponsor a annual shoe give a way to needy children both domestic and abroad. Host annual book give a way to College students in the United States as well as overseas countries, and any activity approved by the Board of Directors which is viewed as an activity to help improve the lives of Students.

Article 4: The initial director of 20/20 Vision of Florida Foundation shall be the initial director's

Article 5: No part of the net earnings of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. shall insure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members or other private persons, except that 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments for lease or rental equipment and distribution in furtherance of the purpose set forth in Article 3 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaigns on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc.

Article 6: Upon the dissolution of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to the State of Florida or local governments for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the Leon County in which the principal office of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. is located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization, as said Court shall determine which are operated exclusively for such purpose.

Article 7: The registered agent and registered office of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc is: Kyle C. Gibson 471 E Van Buren Street Tallahassee, Florida 32301

Article 8: 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida Inc. shall not have members. The qualifications and rights are spelled out in the Bylaws of the corporations.

Article 9: The period of the duration of 20/20 Vision Foundation of Florida is perpetual.
