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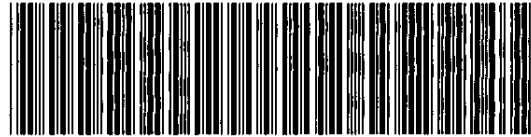

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617.0202, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be: *Jesus' Cadets International, INC.*

ARTICLE II

Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The specific purposes for which the corporation (JESUS' CADETS INTERNATIONAL, INC. (J-DETS)) is organized are:

exclusively religious, charitable, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Jesus' Cadets is a youth organization developed to provide children, with a Christian-based program focused on Social, Mental, Moral, Physical, and Spiritual Health. Youth (children up to the age of eighteen (18) years) are accepted into the program regardless to race, creed, religion or bias. The major focus of the organization is to develop the virtues of personal Confidence, Courage, and Compassion and provides opportunities early in the lives of young people to develop the disciplines of leadership, respect, and obedience.

Jesus' Cadets International, INC (J-DETS) will be the premier world-wide organization educating, training and mentoring youth utilizing Christian principles to take leadership roles in society.

ARTICLE IV

Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

- (1) The board shall consist of twelve (12) members with an annual rotation under the By Laws of the organization. Position of President / CEO of the Organization will remain with the founder until such time that the CEO, relinquishes the position by appointing a suitable replacement or encounter an incapacitating "Act of God," in which case the official board will convene to recommend and elect a replacement.
- (2) The Executive Vice President will be appointed by the President.
- (3) The First Vice President is appointed by the President.
- (4) The Second Vice President is appointed by the President.
- (5) Other appointed positions consist of "Board Members" (5 through 12) from the various J-DETS, International local charters and or community and church leaders.
 - a) Each must be approved by the President.
 - b) Term of office for Board Members (Except CEO) shall be term length, subject to the By Laws of the organization.

ARTICLE V

Limitation of Corporate powers

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501-(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE VI
Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, State or Local Government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction, of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

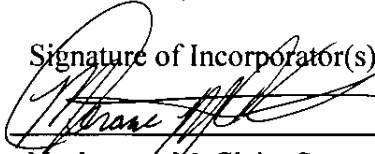

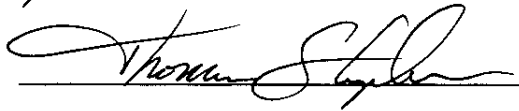
