ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Of HEALING BROKEN HEARTS OUTREACH MINISTRIES, INC. A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, natural person of the age of eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., do hereby set forth:

Article I

Article III The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- a. Healing Broken Hearts Outreach Ministries, Inc. is organized for exclusively religious, charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. Specifically, the organization will be an outreach ministry that will raise funds to provide feeding programs and referral services to the under-served while also promoting the message of the Bible for successful living to those in need, teaching life skills and principles for living as found in the Holy Bible.

No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
