

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not-For-Profit)

ARTICLE I Name of the Corporation

Name of the Corporation shall be AMERIBELGE CENTER FOR EDUCATION, Inc (ABCE).

ARTICLE II Principal Office

The Principal Office of the Corporation shall be located at:

733 NW 2nd Avenue Fort-Lauderdale, FL 33311

ARTICLE III Purpose or Purposes

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized is fallowed

- a) To engage in various charitable activities such as: Education, Advocacy, information/Referrals for families and children as well as individuals residing within the community and abroad, including those in distress and/or affected by the 2010 Haiti earthquake or any other natural disaster.
- b) To disseminate information regarding the community resources and services, make referrals to community providers for appropriate services for needy.
- c) To solicit funding, financial assistance and non-cash assistance such as clothing, food and school material from the government and general public to support families/children and individuals in distress and or victims of natural disaster residing within the country (U.S.A) and abroad .
- d) The Organization shall be a charitable organization to provide services for underprivileged, underserved and unnerved population.
- e) To seek and receive financial assistance from individuals, City, State, Federal and Private Foundations and the General Public.
- IV) In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all the general powers enumerated in Not-For-Profit Corporation Law, together with the power to solicit grants and contributions for the corporate purposes.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the Directors are elected and appointed is by the Incorporator and named as the initial Board of Directors in the Certificate of Incorporation of the Corporation, and they shall hold office until the first Annual Meeting of Members, and until successors have been duly elected and qualified.

IRS FEDRAL TAX EXEMPTION

ARTICLE VII

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income tax under IRC 501(c)(3) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

ARTICLE VIII

No part of the earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, Director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable

compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation), and no member, trustee, officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX

to substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Internal Revenue Code Section 501(h), or participating in, or intervening in (Including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidates for public office.

ARTCLE X

In case of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall after necessary expenses thereof be distributed to another organization exempt under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws, or to the Federal government, or state or local government for public purposes, subject to an order of a Justice of the Supreme court of the State of Florida

ARTICLE XII

In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as described in section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, the corporation shall distribute its Income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under section 4942 of the Code and the corporation shall not (a) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of Code (b) retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943 (c) of the Code (c) make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under section 4944 of the code or (d) make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945 (d) of the code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax Laws.
