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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

A FLORIDA NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a not for profit corporation undertifie Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes; as amended, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

Effective Date Sch 01, 2012

The name of the Corporation shall be <u>WELLINGTON N. GILBERT SCHOLARSHIP</u> FOUNDATION, INC., hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE III: DURATION

The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE V: RESTRICTIONS ON ACTIVITIES

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE VI. MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall be a non-membership organization.

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ARTICLE VII: REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The Corporation's registered office shall be located at 17723 NW 62nd PL N, HIALEAH, FLORIDA 33015 and MEALIE GILBERT is the registered agent of the Corporation at that address.

ARTICLE VIII: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall consist of FOUR (4) persons. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by an amendment to the bylaws; however, there shall never be less than three directors. All directors shall be selected as provided for in the bylaws.
