ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation shall be:

Messianic Jewish International Council Corporation

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL ADDRESS/OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this Corporation shall be:

708 NW 42 ST
OAKLAND PARK, FL 33306

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is exclusively for the following objectives:

1. Integrated communities, synagogues, congregations, rabbis, leaders and institutions and messianic-Jew ministries.
2. Promote the harmony between the Messianic Jewish leadership of communities, congregations, synagogues and related, national and international agencies.
3. Provide organizational representation before the competent authorities; When it is necessary to highlight the interests and point of view of Jewish Messianic and give support, coverage and protection in situations of risk.
4. Provide national and international organizational representation.
5. Promote in common agreement, seminars for training, conferences, Yeshivot, concerts and messianic meetings, national and international.
6. Recognize leadership and ministries that qualify, whose work has been confirmed by the healthy rise of a new messianic Jewish community.
7. Meet in ordinary and extraordinary form wherever necessary to rabbis and leaders associated to treat matters of common interest.

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ARTICLE IV

LIMITATIONS

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the Corporation:

- 1- This Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and State income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of any future United States Internal Revenue rule.
- 2- The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profit or dividends to the Directors, Officers or Members thereof or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's purposes.
- 3- The property, assets, profits and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to the use and development of the Corporation no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.
- 4- No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 5- Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the I.R.Code of 1896 to be used exclusively for non profits purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

ARTICLE V

DURATION

The period of duration for this Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

DOCTRINAL IDENTITY

1. In order to maintain the unity and doctrinal identity and thus present with integrity the testimony of Yeshua, the Jewish Messiah, we believe:
 - a. In the faith based on the principles set forth in the Scriptures (Tanak [Navim, Torah and Ketuvim] and the writings of the Brith Ha-hadashá (New Covenant).)

- b. In the Israel Elohim of Torah as expressed it in the Shema: "Shema Israel Adonai Eloheino, Adonai echad".
 - c. On the belief and hope in the Jewish Messiah Yeshua as a prerequisite for redemption, and the sufficient grace of Elohim manifested to man since ancient times, which excludes the human merits.
 - d. Believe in the action of the Ruaj ha-Kodesh in the life of the community for its development as a light of the Nations.
 - e. We believe that the Jewish Yeshua is the Messiah promised to Israel and that in him dwells all the fullness of Elohim.
 - f. We believe in the imminent second coming of Yeshua ha-Mashiach for the establishment of the Messianic Kingdom.
2. Liturgical differences, customs and messianic positions observed by each congregation represented by their rabbis and leaders must be respected.

ARTICLE VII

MEMBERSHIP

Individuals and Congregations shall be eligible to membership in this body who give evidence on a personal living faith in Yeshua ha-Mashiach and who voluntarily adhere to the Corporation Doctrinal principles and agree to be governed by its constitution and under the conditions stated on its by-laws as herein forth.

Any associate may renounce their membership by their own free will, or it may be withdrawn by two-thirds of the Assembly decision.

ARTICLE VIII

SELECTIONS FOR DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

The Directors are elected or appointed by the Constituent Board and this method is stated in the by-laws of the Corporation.

Members of the directive may waive its role by their own free will or may be replaced by two-thirds of the Assembly decision.

Accurate record shall be maintained of all the finances and will be informed to the Board in periodical occasions as stated in the by-laws. All records shall be such that they provide concise, adequate information and documentation.

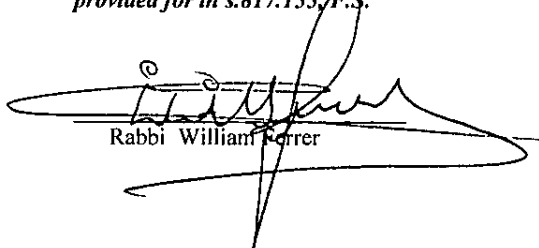
