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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S.

## **ARTICLE ONE**

## ORGANIZATIONAL NAME AND OFFICES

The West Florida High School Band Boosters, Inc., hereafter referred to as the Boosters, is a non-profit organization established to support all performing organizations including the auxiliary units of the West Florida High School Band and its Director.

# **ARTICLE TWO**

## **BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS**

The principal office of the Boosters shall be located at 2400 Longleaf Drive, Pensacola, 32526, County of Escambia, State of Florida. The organization may have such other offices as the Board of Directors may determine form time to time.

# **ARTICLE THREE**

## **PURPOSE OF ORGANIZATION**

The object of the Boosters is to support the West Florida High School Band and to undertake such activities to this end as may be determined by the membership. The purposes of which the West Florida High School Band Boosters, Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are except as organizations described in section 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government of exclusive public purpose.

The Corporation may conduct programs and activities, raise funds, request and receive grants, gifts, contributions, due and bequests of monies, real and personal property or acquire, receive, hold,

invest and administer in its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other property, real and personal and make expenditures and distributions for the benefit of West Florida High School Band and/or Color/Winter Guard.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying of of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) and political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## **ARTICLE FOUR**

## **OFFICERS**

**SECTION 1. OFFICERS:** The Officers of the Executive Board shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Director of Fundraising. The Executive Board may elect or appoint other officers as needed. Duties of these offices will be documented in the Guidelines for Committee Responsibilities document. The same person may hold more than one office at a time except the offices of President and Secretary.

**SECTION 2. ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE**: The members at the annual meeting shall elect the officers of the organization for the following year. If the election of officers is not elected at such meeting, such election shall be held as soon thereafter as is convenient. New offices may be created and filled at any meeting of the West Florida Band Boosters. Each officer shall hold office for a period of one year or until his successor has been duly qualified and elected.

**SECTION 3. VACANCIES**: A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, dismissal, disqualification or otherwise, may be filled by the Executive Board for the unexpired portion of the term. The Executive Board may dismiss any member of the Board if in its judgment the best intent of the organization would be served thereby.

**SECTION 4. INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS.** All officers and directors shall be indemnified by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities including attorney's fees (including appellate proceedings) reasonable incurred in connection with any proceeding or settlement thereof in which they may become involved by reason of holding such office. The Corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of all officers and directors against any liability asserted against them or incurred by them in their capacity as officers and directors or arising out of their status as such.

## **ARTICLE FIVE**

## **BY-LAWS**

The By-Laws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors and Membership at the annual meeting each year and may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided in the By-Laws.
