ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF 1801 ASSOCIATION, INC.

A Florida Corporation Not For Profit

The undersigned incorporator, a resident of the State of Florida, and of full age, hereby makes, subscribes, acknowledges and files with the Department of the State of Florida these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is **1801 ASSOCIATION**, **INC.**, a Florida corporation not for profit (hereinafter called the "Association" in these Articles). The principal office and mailing address of this Corporation is 2255 Glades Road, Suite 324-A, Boca Raton, FL 33431.

ARTICLE II OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

This Association's registered office is 2255 Glades Road, Suite 324-A, Boca Raton, FL 33431, Palm Beach County, Florida, and its registered agent is ROBERT A. FORLIZZO, who maintains an office at 2903 Rigsby Lane, Safety Harbor, Florida 34695. Both this Association's registered office and registered agent may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors as provided by law.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to its Members and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for the maintenance, preservation and repair of certain areas within the Plat of 1801 Clint Moore Road, recorded at Plat Book 116, Pages 21 and 22, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida (the "Plat"), as provided in the By-Laws of the Association as said By-Laws may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV POWERS

Without limitation, this Association is empowered to:

- (a) Own and convey property.
- (b) Operate and maintain the areas described in Article III hereof.
- (c) Establish rules and regulations.
- (d) Assess Members and enforce said assessments.
- (e) Sue and be sued.
- (f) Contract for services to provide for operation and maintenance if the Association contemplates employing a maintenance company.
- (g) Require each owner of a Lot as described in the Plat to be a Member. If a Lot is entirely leased ("Land Lease") to one entity ("Land Lessee"), that entity shall be the Member in place of the Owner as long as the Lease is in existence and not in default beyond the expiration of any applicable notice and cure periods therefor. Upon a termination of the Land Lease or an uncured default in said Land Lease which remains uncured beyond the expiration of any applicable notice and cure periods therefor, the Owner of the Lot shall be entitled to vote on behalf of such Lot.
 - (h) Exist in perpetuity.
- (i) Take any other action necessary for the purposes for which the Association is organized.
- (j) Rules. From time to time adopt, alter, amend, rescind and enforce reasonable rules and regulations governing the use of the common area consistent with the rights and duties established by these Articles.
- (k) General. Have and exercise all common law rights, powers and privileges and those that a corporation not for profit may now or hereafter have or exercise under the laws of the State of Florida, together with all other rights, powers and privileges reasonable to be implied from the existence of any right, power or privilege so granted. The Association may enter into litigation, mediation or arbitration to enforce their rights as stated herein or to defend themselves against any claims made against the Association.
- (l) Enforcement. To enforce by legal means the obligations of the Members of the Corporation, the provisions of the Declaration, and the provision of the dedication or conveyance of the corporate property to the Corporation with respect to the use and maintenance thereof.

ARTICLE V VOTING RIGHTS

The Association shall have one (1) class of voting membership which shall be comprised of the Owners or Land Lessees (as defined in the By-Laws), as the case may be, of Lots subject to the Plat. Each Lot shall have one (1) vote.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP

Every person who from time to time holds the record fee simple title to, or any undivided fee simple interest in or as a Land Lessee of, any Lot that is subject to the Plat is a member of this Association, but excluding all other persons who hold any interest in any Lot merely as security for the performance of an obligation. Membership is appurtenant to, and may not be separated from, ownership of each Lot that is subject to the provisions of the Plat.

ARTICLE VII ASSESSMENTS

The Board of Directors of the Association shall prepare a budget for the maintenance obligations of the Association as described in Article III pursuant to provisions of the Associations Bylaws and shall have the power to assess each Member for such maintenance costs as provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. This Association's affairs are managed by a Board of Directors initially composed of three (3) Directors. The initial Directors are named below. The term of office for all Directors is three (3) years. Each Member shall appoint one (1) Director who shall serve such Director's term unless replaced by the Member entitled to appoint said Director. Before any such annual meeting, all vacancies occurring on the Board of Directors, if any, will be filled by the Member entitled to appoint said Director. Any Director may succeed himself or herself in office. Directors need not be Association Members.

Express reference is made to the Declaration and Plat where necessary to interpret, construe, and clarify the provisions of the Articles. Without limitation, all terms defined in the Declaration and Plat have the same meaning where used in these Articles. By subscribing and filing these Articles, the incorporators intend its provisions to be consistent with the provisions of the Declaration and to be interpreted, construed, and applied with those of the Declaration and Plat to avoid inconsistencies or conflicting results.
