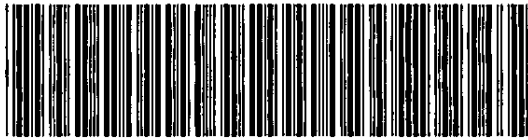

Article 2

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

Article 3

PURPOSE

Said Organization is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, public benefit and scientific organization purposes. Frazier Outreach Foundation, Inc. will help to advance education, lessen neighborhood tensions, combat community, detention, as well as facilitate relief of the poor, the distressed and the under privileged. Frazier Outreach Foundation, Inc. is dedicated to helping citizens in the community to become self-sustainable individuals and productive members of society. Frazier Outreach Foundation, Inc. will include a plan of action to help improve participant's quality of life and ultimately their purpose for existing, also known as destiny.

Article 4

MANNER OF ELECTION

The management of the affairs of Frazier Outreach Foundation, Inc. shall be vested in a Membership/Board of Directors. The Executive Director or his or her acting Executive Director may appoint Board of Directors in the untimely vacancy of a Director. The Board of Directors will conduct interviews to fill vacant Board of Directors seats, including media, publications, and advertising. The range of Membership/Board of Directors is 3-7.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Article 5

PROHIBITIONS

- 1) No part of the earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes of this article hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in in opposition to any candidate in public office.

- 2) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 6

DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or so disposed of shall be disposed of by Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal officer of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
