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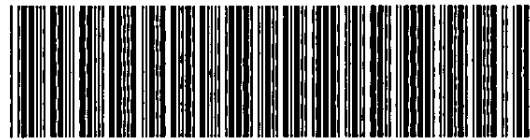

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I - Name: The name of the corporation shall be: Military Officers Association of America, Ancient City Chapter, Charitable, Educational and Scientific Fund, Inc.

Article II - Principle Office: 1033 Inverness Dr., St Augustine, FL 32092-2787

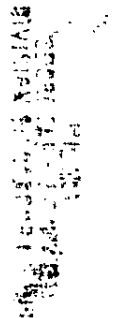
Article III - Purpose: The purpose for which the Military Officers Association of America, Ancient City Chapter, Charitable, Educational and Scientific Fund, Inc. is organized is to promote the purposes and objectives of the Military Officers Association of America; to foster fraternal relations among retired, active duty, and former officers of the uniformed services; protect the rights and interests of active duty, retired, reserve component and their dependents and survivors; provide services for members and their dependents and survivors; and support of Chapter's related endeavors, charitable, cultural, educational, and scientific purposes (to include military science) in accordance with section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article VIII Additional Provisions: The purpose of this Military Officers Association of America, Ancient City Chapter, Charitable, Educational and Scientific Fund, Inc. is irrevocably dedicated to support of Chapter endeavors, charitable, cultural, educational and scientific purposes (to include military science). Upon the dissolution or winding up of the Military Officers Association of America, Ancient City Chapter, Charitable, Educational and Scientific Fund, Inc., its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, cultural, educational, and scientific purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. No substantial part of the activities of the Military Officers Association of America, Ancient City Chapter, Charitable, Educational and Scientific Fund, Inc. shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation [except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code], and the Military Officers Association of America, Ancient City Chapter, Charitable, Educational and Scientific Fund, Inc. shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
