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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FIND YOUR FABULOSITY, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, the undersigned serves as incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation not-for-profit and does hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is Find Your Fabulosity, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE CORPORATION

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation shall be 302 Smokerise Blvd., Longwood, Florida 32779.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES AND POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- (1) To collect new/never-used lipsticks for donation to women's domestic violence shelters, to be distributed/given to women residents/victims; lipstick represents helping a woman victim "find her voice, identity, and beauty inside and out."
- (2) Provide education on domestic violence/abuse and dating violence/abuse, and how to prevent and stop these atrocities via the Corporation's website, community outreach, public speaking, and social media channels.
- (3) Provide basic supportive resources for women victims of domestic violence/abuse and dating violence/abuse.

This Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to its members, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are:

- (1) exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and/or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws governing the distributions to organizations qualified as tax-exempt; and
- (2) except as limited by the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws, the Corporation will have and exercise all rights and powers in furtherance of its purposes as are or may hereafter be conferred on not for profit corporations pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and in accordance with other applicable law.

Not withstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

<u>ARTICLE IV</u>

MANNER OF ELECTION

The affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The method of election or appointment of the Board of Directors shall be fixed and governed by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI

DISSOLUTION

A majority of the Board of Directors may authorize dissolution of the Corporation. After dissolution is authorized, the Corporation must file articles of dissolution, in compliance with Section 617.1403, Florida Statutes, with the Department of State.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this Corporation, its remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to a not for profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE VII
