ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AND LITERACY FOR ALL, INC.

The undersigned natural person, of the age of twenty-one years or more, adding as SSEE FLORIDA Incorporator of a Corporation not-for-profit under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the Corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation (the "Corporation") is And Literacy For All, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are to promote charitable, literary, and educational activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, but not limited to the provision of literacy resources, education, and programs which empower individuals and build community through the acquisition and enhancement of literacy skills.

The Corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, officers, directors or other private persons or any other individuals, except that this Corporation may make payments of reasonable compensation for services rendered, and payments for expenses incurred in the furtherance of its purposes, as stated in these Articles of Incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. The Corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit.

Notwithstanding any provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal taxes as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or provisions of any future Federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the

corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

<u>ARTICLE IV – DIRECTORS ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT</u>

The manner in which Directors shall be elected or appointed shall be provided by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

<u>ARTICLE V – INITIAL DIRECTORS</u>

ARTICLE VIII - FUNDS AND ASSETS, DISSOLUTION

The Corporation shall use its funds only to accomplish the purposes stated in these Articles of Incorporation. The period of the Corporation's duration shall be perpetual, or

until, such time as the Board of Directors adopts a resolution recommending that the Corporation be dissolved pursuant to the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this Corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to, and only to, one or more charitable organizations that qualify as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IX - BYLAWS

The board of directors shall have the power to adopt, amend, or repeal the Bylaws of the Corporation. The Bylaws shall govern the operation of this Corporation unless any Bylaw conflicts with these Articles of Incorporation, in which case the Articles of Incorporation shall be controlling.
