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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE MATCHMAKING MISSION, INC.**

The undersigned incorporator to these articles of incorporation hereby forms a corporation not for profit (the "Corporation") under the laws of the State of Florida as follows:

ARTICLE I

Name, Principal Place of Business, and Mailing Address

The name of the Corporation is: The Matchmaking Mission, Inc. The principal place of business is 4308 W Woodmere Rd., Tampa, FL 33609 and the mailing address is: 4308 W Woodmere Rd., Tampa, FL 33609.

ARTICLE II

Term of Existence

The date when corporate existence shall commence shall be the date of the filing of these articles of incorporation by the office of the Florida Department of State and the Corporation shall have perpetual existence thereafter.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code (the "Code"), including, but not limited to:

1. Matching categorized donated items with organizations and charities (Recipients) that can maximize utilization of such donated items in furtherance of Recipients' specific charitable missions;
2. Easing the burden on Recipients that accept donations of goods by encouraging and facilitating donor discretion and sorting;
3. Restoring the dignity and self-respect of low-income individuals by providing them direct access to low-cost, higher-end gifts and personal items for themselves and their loved ones;
4. Maximizing and easing the burden of the transfer of useful goods from homes with plenty to homes in need; and
5. Reducing the level of well-functioning personal and home goods which end up in landfills.

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The Corporation shall have all powers now or hereafter granted by law, and in addition thereto shall have all powers lawfully necessary or required to carry out its purposes and objects. All of the assets or earnings shall be used exclusively for the purposes hereinabove set out, including payment of expenses incidental thereto.

ARTICLE IV
Members

The qualifications of members and the manner of admission of members shall be as specified in the bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V
Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of the Company is 4308 W Woodmere Rd., Tampa, FL 33609, and the name of its initial registered agent at that address Radha V. Bachman.

ARTICLE VI
Directors

The Corporation shall have four (4) directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time and their election and appointment shall be as specified in the bylaws of the Corporation, provided that the Corporation shall always have at least three (3) directors. ARTICLE X
Dissolution


Upon a dissolution of the Corporation, the residual assets of the Corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Code, or to the federal, state, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE XI
Limitations

Section 1. Legislative and Political Activity. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements in connection with) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Section 2. Property. The property, assets, profits, and net income of the Corporation are dedicated irrevocably to the purposes set forth herein. No part of the Corporation's profits or net earnings shall inure to the benefit of its directors, officers, members, or to the benefit of any private individual.
