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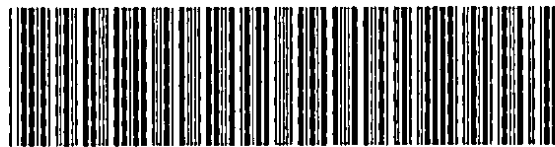

**CONSTITUTION BYLAWS OF THE
INTERNATIONAL CHURCH OF SILOAM
(A Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code)**

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Preamble

This constitution and bylaws are made to:

1. Preserve and secure the principles of our faith.
2. Preserve the liberties of each individual member of the church.
3. Ensure freedom of action of independence from any religious body or organization.
4. Provide for orderly conduct of internal affairs, in dealing with others and of governing church member.

Article I

Name and location

The name of this corporation is INTERNATIONAL CHURCH OF SILOAM. This corporation will be further referred to in the bylaws as the " Church". The church office is presently located at 501 Blairstone road Apt.1203 – Tallahassee, FL 32301. The church shall have full power and authority to change the principal office from one location to another.

Article II

Purpose

The purpose of this church is to glorify God by obeying the Great Commandment (Mathew 22:36-40) and the Great commission (Matthew 28:18-20). The process is designed to produce the disciples of Jesus Christ which involves at least the following four categories.

1. Worship-(Celebrating) " To love God with all your heart"....(Matt. 22:36-40)
2. Ministry- (Caring and assistance to families)" Love your neighbor as yourself...." (Matt. 22:36-40); I was naked and you clothed Me,..(Matt 25:36)
3. Evangelism- (Cultivating) "Go....and make disciples...." (Matt 28:18-20)
4. Discipleship- (Communicating)"Teach them to observe....(Matt. 28:18-20)

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Article III

Statement of Faith

1. We believe the bible to be inspired ,infallible, authoritative Word of God.
2. We believe there is One God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy spirit according to mark 1:10-11 that says: And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit as a dove descending upon him: And there came a voice from heaven, saying thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.(KJV)
3. We believe in the deity of Jesus, in his virgin birth, in his sinless life, in his miracles, and in our redemption through his shed blood.
4. We believe in his bodily resurrection, in his ascension to the right hand of the father, and in his imminent return in power and glory.
5. We believe the regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential for the salvation of lost and sinful men.
6. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our lord Jesus Christ.

Article IV

Affiliation

This church is autonomous and maintains the right to govern its own affairs, independent of any denomination control. The church recognizes, however, the benefits of cooperation with other churches and ministries in word mission.

Article V

Membership

Section 1: Members

This ministry is comprised of persons who have been baptized by immersion and profess a personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and are in agreement with the statement of faith of the church.

Section 2: Rights of Members

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- Vote: Every active member is entitled to one vote. Acts 1:15-26
- Be informed about ministry's activities(spiritual and financially activities)
Exodus 38:24-29
- Every active member shall have the right to participate in the following matters:
The annual budget of the church, the disposition of all or substantially all of the assets of the church, the merger or dissolution of the church, acquisition of property, and the amendments of the articles of the Incorporation or Bylaws of the church.

Section 3: Termination:

Membership in this church shall be terminated when a member:

1. Is dropped from the roll of membership. A letter of termination is not necessary.
2. Dies.
3. Is dismissed by a vote of the church member due to reasons and circumstances provided in the church discipline. The vision team will do all they can to counsel the member for restoration prior to action of dismissal or a request of the member to be dismissed from the church membership.

Article VI

Meetings of Members

Business meetings of the members shall be held in the times, in the manner and the purposes set forth below:

1. An annual meeting of the church shall be held prior to the beginning of the calendar year. The primary of the meeting is to receive and adopt the annual report and church budget.
2. The church may change the dates of the annual or other scheduled meetings by notifying the members at least 10 days in advance.
3. A special business meeting of the church may be called at any time by (a) the Pastor,(b) or in absence of the Pastor by any other officer of the church.
4. A quorum shall consist of those members present and voting.

Article VII.

Nonprofit Status and Liquidation

This church is not organized for profit.

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of the Section 501c (3) of the internal revenue code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including for such purposes, the making distributions to organization that also qualify as Section 501 c(3) exempt organizations.

- (I) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein;
- (II) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office except as authorized under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended;
- (III) The corporation shall not carrying on other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

Article VIII

Church officers

(Directors of the corporation)

Section I

The officers of the church will consist of a minimum of three persons. Each officer will be an active member of the church in good standing

Section II

- a. The Pastor will serve as the president of the corporation and will be the moderator of the church. He will lead the staff and have the responsibility to hire and dismiss staff as needed. In the absence of the Pastor the church can approve a moderator to serve by majority vote.

- b. The chief financial officer of the corporation will oversee and cause to be kept and maintained, adequate and correct books and record of account of the corporation. He or she shall also oversee the reception and disbursement of funds.
- c. The Church Clerk will serve as the Secretary of the Corporation.
- d. Others trustee officers shall be appointed by the Pastor and approved by the church as needed.

Article IX

Church Committees

1) VISION

This committee is responsible of the vision. They take decision for the ministry's activities in fasting and prayers (annual spiritual activities....).

- Pastor,
- Prayers and Deliverance;
- Conferences, seminars and crusades;
- Youth;
- Worship and music;
- Membership and Partnership;
- Education

2) ADMINISTRATION

This committee manages the ministry's provision(all kind of donations received)in order to accomplish THE VISION.

- Senior Pastor;
- Clerk;
- Chief Financial officer;

3) OUTREACH COMMITTEE

This committee is under the leadership of the pastor. He forms a committee to develop and implement a strategy for effective programs of community evangelistic outreach such as visitation, Bible studies in homes, offices, places of works, special evangelistic meetings inside and outside the church; and other needed programs to reach people with the gospel(conferences, conventions, seminars, crusades, etc....)

Article X.

Corporate responsibility

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious purposes, and non part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of a director, officer or member of the corporation, or to benefit of any private individual.

Article XI.

Amendment

New Bylaws may be adopted, or these Bylaws may be amended or repealed by the affirmative vote of a two-thirds, majority of the votes represented at a duly held meeting of the members.
