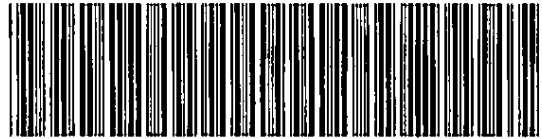


ARTICLE VIII


