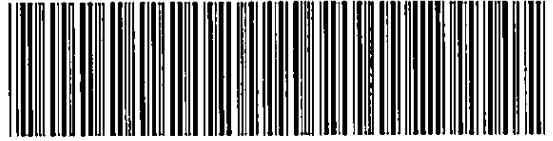

Collasuyo Archaeological Research Institute Inc. members engage in cutting-edge and internationally respected research funded by universities, public and private grants, and private donors. Collasuyo Archaeological Research Institute Inc. supports archaeological education in southern Peru. The Collasuyo Archaeological Research Institute Inc. facility, collections, and equipment facilitate graduate education and PhD research. Associates also operate archaeological projects and field schools that train undergraduate and graduate students from the U.S., providing cultural immersion experiences and technical archaeological training essential to gain employment in the archaeological sector. Associates train local Peruvian students and community members in archaeological methods, curation of archaeological artifacts, and protection of heritage sites using Collasuyo Archaeological Research Institute Inc.'s equipment in the field and in the lab facility.
