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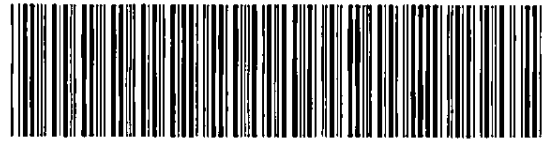

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

PORT ST. LUCIE BLACK WOMEN WALK, INC.

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S.
(A Florida Not For Profit Corporation)

The undersigned, acting as President of Port St. Lucie Black Women Walk Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation (the "Corporation"), does hereby certify the following Restated Articles of Incorporation:

Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation were filed with the Secretary of State of Florida on December 10, 2024, Document Number: N24000014288.

These Restated Articles of Incorporation do not contain amendments requiring member approval. The Board of Directors adopted these Restated Articles of Incorporation on December 13, 2024.

These Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.

Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Florida not-for-profit corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation is PORT ST. LUCIE BLACK WOMEN WALK, INC.

ARTICLE II: ADDRESS

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized:

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The specific purpose of the corporation is to promote and improve the health and well-being of the local community through walking programs, health education, and support services.

ARTICLE IV: ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which directors are elected or appointed is:

As provided for in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V: POWERS

The corporation shall have all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida necessary and convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized, provided that no such power shall be exercised in a manner inconsistent with the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VI: NONPROFIT STATUS AND COMPENSATION

The corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof as described in section 501(c)(3).

ARTICLE VII: RESTRICTIONS

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VIII: DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the

principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX: MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have no voting members.

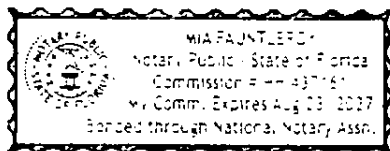
