Dear Sir or Madam:

I enclose a \$122.50 check payable to the Department of State as payment for the 2000 and 2001 Annual Report Fee. It is my understanding that you can waive the reinstatement fee as determined on a case by case basis. I ask that you take the following facts into consideration with regards to the 2000 administrative reinstatement fee.

At the annual election, that was held in late February, 2000, several new officers were elected to the board and the corporate records were turned over to the new board in a state of disarray. In addition, the association was without a central mailing location and the corporate records and notices were being mailed to an officer who was no longer serving on the board.

Upon review of the corporate records, the newly elected officers determined that the annual report was due and requested the treasurer, Gary Thornton, to issue a \$61.25 check for payment of the annual report fees and forward the check along with the Annual Report to the Department of State. However, Mr. Thornton did not issue the check since he was in the process of resigning as treasurer. When Mr. Thornton resigned, the association was unable to fill the treasurer position for quite some time.


In Mr. Thornton's absence, the association was unable to issue any checks since he was the only authorized signatory on the account. The association had difficulty filling the position and the bank was requiring a new treasurer in order to issue checks from the account. There were also insufficient new funds being received since most of the members paid their voluntary dues at the annual meeting and those funds were deposited into the operating account by Mr. Thornton prior to his resignation.

The treasurer position was filled only recently and we are now able to submit payment along with the annual report. In order to avoid this situation from arising in the future, we have acquired a post office box and added an additional signatory on the bank account to avoid any further delays in payment.

Willoughby Acres Property Owners Association, Inc., is a voluntary association that operates on an extremely low budget. The reinstatement fee would have a dramatic impact on the association.

I request that you kindly waive the reinstatement fee and thank you for your consideration.
