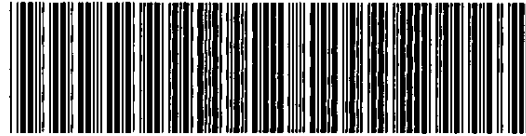

Hello,

I am the treasurer of a non-profit organization that was incorporated in 1988. I have recently found out that the EIN listed with the FL Division of Corporations is not the correct number. Apparently, the organization changed bank accounts several years ago and a previous treasurer used his or her own social security number to open the account. We were misinformed about the number, thinking it was our proper EIN, when in fact, it was not.

After speaking with an agent with the IRS, we now have the correct EIN. Our organization is also listed incorrectly, beginning with the word, "the."

There is no "the" at the beginning in the official IRS records.

Question: How do we change the EIN so you have the correct number and also make a minor adjustment to the name of the organization?

I am also the registered agent in addition to being the treasurer.
