AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION ROYAL WOOD SINGLE FAMILY HOMES ASSOCIATION, INC.

SUBSTANTIAL REWORDING OF ARTICLES - SEE CURRENT ARTICLES FOR CURRENT TEXT



Pursuant to Section 617.1007, Florida Statutes, the Articles of Incorporation of Royal Wood Single Family Homes Association, Inc., a Florida corporation not for profit, which was originally incorporated under the same name on November 9, 1988, are hereby amended and restated in their entirety. All amendments included herein have been adopted pursuant to Section 617.0201(4), Florida Statutes, and there is no discrepancy between the corporation's Articles of Incorporation as heretofore amended and the provisions of these Amended and Restated Articles other than the inclusion of amendments adopted pursuant to Section 617.0201(4) and the omission of matters of historical interest. The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of Royal Wood Single Family Homes Association, Inc., shall henceforth be as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of the corporation is Royal Wood Single Family Homes Association, Inc., sometimes hereinafter referred to as the "Association."

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The principal office of the corporation is located at Royal Wood Single Family Homes Association, Inc., c/o Royal Wood Golf & Country Club, 4300 Royalwood Boulevard, Naples, Florida 34112.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE AND POWERS: This Association will not permit pecuniary gain or profit and will make no distribution of its income to its members, officers or Directors. It is a corporation not for profit organized on a non-stock basis for the purpose of establishing a corporate residential neighborhood homeowners association which will, subject to a Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions recorded in the Public Records of Collier County, Florida, have the powers described herein. The Association shall have all of the common law and statutory powers of a Florida corporation not for profit consistent with these Articles and with the Declaration of

Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions to which these Articles shall be an exhibit; and it shall have all of the powers and authority reasonably necessary or appropriate to the operation and regulation of a residential neighborhood, subject to the Declaration, as it may from time to time be amended, including but not limited to the power to:

- (A) Fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by an lawful means all charges or assessments liens pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the corporation, including all license fees, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the corporation;
- (B) Acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise) own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the corporation;
- (C) Borrow money, and mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;
- (D) Participate in mergers and consolidations with other associations organized for the same or similar purposes, provided that merger or consolidation shall require the consent of at least a majority of the voting interests of the Association;
- (E) Exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, may now or hereafter have or exercise; subject always to the Declaration, as amended from time to time;
- (F) Assist, cooperatively, with Royal Wood Master Association, in the administration and enforcement of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for Royal Wood Golf & Country Club.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP AND VOTING RIGHTS: Membership and voting rights shall be as set forth in Section 3 of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions and Section 2 of the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V

TERM: The term of the Association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

BYLAWS: The Bylaws of the Association may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided therein.

ARTICLE VII

AMENDMENTS: Amendments to these Articles shall be proposed and adopted in the following manner:

- (A) <u>Proposal.</u> Amendments to these Articles may be proposed by a majority of the Board or by petition to the Board signed by at least one-fourth (1/4th) of the voting interests.
- (B) <u>Procedure.</u> A proposed amendment must be submitted to a vote of the members not later than the next annual meeting for which proper notice can still be given.
- (C) <u>Vote Required.</u> Except as otherwise required by Florida law, a proposed amendment to these Articles of Incorporation shall be adopted if it is approved at any annual or special meeting called for the purpose by at least a majority of the voting interests of the Association, or if it is approved in writing by a majority of the voting interests without a meeting, as authorized in Section 3.11 of the Bylaws, provided that notice of any proposed amendment must be given to the members of the Association, and the notice must contain the full text of the proposed amendment.
- (D) <u>Effective Date.</u> An amendment becomes effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and recording a certified copy in the Public Records of Collier County, Florida, with the same formalities as are required in the Declaration for recording amendments to the Declaration.

ARTICLE VIII

DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS:

- (A) The affairs of the Association will be administered by a Board of Directors consisting of the number of Directors determined by the Bylaws, but not less than three (3) Directors, and in the absence of such determination shall consist of three (3) Directors.
- (B) Directors shall be elected by the members in the manner determined by the Bylaws. Directors may be removed and vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled in the manner provided by the Bylaws.

(C) The business of the Association shall be conducted by the officers designated in the Bylaws. The officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors at its first meeting following the annual meeting of the members of the Association and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.

ARTICLE IX

INDEMNIFICATION: To the fullest extent permitted by Florida law, the Association shall indemnify and hold harmless every Director and every officer of the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including attorneys fees, actually and reasonably incurred by or imposed on him in connection with any legal proceeding (or settlement or appeal of such proceeding) to which he may be a party because of his being or having been a Director or officer of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall not be available if a judgment or other final adjudication establishes that his actions or omissions to act were material to the cause adjudicated and involved:

- (A) Willful misconduct or a conscious disregard for the best interests of the Association, in a proceeding by or in the right of the Association to procure a judgment in its favor.
- (B) A violation of criminal law, unless the Director or officer had no reasonable cause to believe his action was unlawful or had reasonable cause to believe his action was lawful.
- (C) A transaction from which the Director or officer derived an improper personal benefit.
- (D) Wrongful conduct by Directors or officers appointed by the Developer, in a proceeding brought by or on behalf of the Association.

In the event of an out-of-court settlement, the right to indemnification shall not apply unless a majority of the disinterested Directors approves the settlement as being in the best interest of the Association. The foregoing rights of indemnification shall be in addition to, and not exclusive of all other rights to which a Director or officer may be entitled.
