ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE FIRST ORLANDO FOUNDATION, INC.

FORETARY OF STATE LLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1007, of the Florida Statutes, THE FIRST ORLANDO FOUNDATION, INC., a not-for-profit corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following Restated Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name of Corporation

The name of this corporation shall be THE FIRST ORLANDO FOUNDATION, INC. (hereinafter the "Foundation").

ARTICLE II

Address, Offices and Registered Agent

The street address of the principal office of this Foundation is 3000 South John Young Parkway, Orlando, Florida 32805-6691. The street address of the registered office of this Foundation is 3000 South John Young Parkway, Orlando, Florida 32805-6691. The name of the registered agent for the Foundation is Randall James. The address of the principal office of the Foundation may hereafter be at such place within or without the City of Orlando as may be convenient or desirable.

ARTICLE III

Powers, Objects and Purposes

This Foundation is organized exclusively for educational, religious and charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which the Foundation is organized are:

- (a) to assist in and contribute to the growth and development of the ministries and activities of The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc., including The First Academy, and other activities and ministries of the Church;
- (b) to provide financial assistance with tuition and other fees to those students of The First Academy who, through merit or need, are worthy of such assistance; and
- (c) to solicit gifts and bequests and to administer funds received in connection with the purposes of the Foundation.

This Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable and philanthropic purposes, including the specific object and purpose of providing monetary contributions to a qualified organization, The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc. (The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc., is a Florida non-profit corporation, that is itself tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and to which contributions are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.)

This Foundation shall be authorized to exercise the powers permitted non-profit corporations under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes; provided, however, that this Foundation, in exercising any one or more of such powers, shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purposes for which it has been organized within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and provided further that this Foundation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation

exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (b) a corporation to which contributions are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE IV

Membership

The sole voting member and the sole member of the Foundation shall be The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc.

ARTICLE V

Term

This Foundation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE VI

Directors

Section 1. The number of Directors constituting the Board shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Foundation; provided, however, that there shall never be less than three (3) Directors.

Section 2. Directors shall have such qualifications as may be required by the Bylaws of the Foundation. The manner of the selection and the manner of the discharge of the Directors of the Foundation shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Foundation.

ARTICLE VII

Non-Profit Status and Dissolution

Section 1. No part of the net earnings of the Foundation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its Directors, officers or other private persons, except that the Foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the Foundation or on its behalf and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Section 2. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the Foundation will be turned over to The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc., a Florida non-profit corporation, and if The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc., has ceased to exist as an incorporated entity, then to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding sections of any future law, or to the federal, state, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE VIII

Bylaws

The Bylaws of the Foundation shall be adopted and may be altered, amended, repealed or supplemented only by the voting member, The First Baptist Church of Orlando, Inc.

ARTICLE IX

Amendment to Articles of Incorporation

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the voting member in accordance with the procedure provided by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE X

Commencement of Foundation's Corporate Existence

The corporate existence of this Foundation commenced on May 17, 1989.


