Articles of amendment to articles of incorporation of

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

MANNER OF ADOPTION

The amendments were adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

These Articles of Amendment were adopted by the board of directors of said organization at a regular meeting with a quorum being present which was held on December 16, 2010. This meeting of the directors met the requirements of both the Articles of Incorporation and the bylaws.

THE AMENDMENTS

The Articles of Incorporation of the HOLMWOOD PAST STUDENT ASSOCIATION, SOUTH FLORIDA CHAPTER, INC. are hereby amended as follows:

- 3. Article 3. PURPOSE is amended to add section d. Article 3.d. reads as follows
 - **d.** To make distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- **4.** The following additional Articles are hereby added to the Articles of Incorporation.

SECRETARY OF STATE DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS

Article 12 reads as follows:

12. NO PRIVATE INUREMENT

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 3. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 13 reads as follows:

13. DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government, for a public surpose.
