## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

SHEKINAH "RENAISSANCE" MINISTRIES, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation filed April 5, 1995, under File Number N95000001598:

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation is SHEKINAH "RENAISSANCE" MINISTRIES, INC., a not for profit corporation.

## ARTICLE III - PURPOSES AND POWERS A. PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

- 1. This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, educational, charitable, and scientific purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future Internal Revenue law) including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future Internal Revenue law).
- 2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, this corporation shall have the following purposes:
  - (a) The corporation shall function under the umbrella of the principals, rules and regulations of the Church of God, and as such will assist disfunctional family members in getting back on track, by offering services for physical, emotional, spiritual and social needs.
  - (b) The corporation is and shall be empowered to train and assist displaced workers in their return to the work force, and to assist them in job placement.
  - (c) The corporation shall engage in and be supportive of Christian education, social services, scientific research, and other charitable endeavors.

The corporation shall also provide temporary room and board for disadvantaged persons; early childhood care and training for unwed mothers or qualifying families; home economic training; basic human resource needs; and mission field training for foreign missions.

- (d) The corporation shall be empowered to disseminate information of the organization's available services by the medium of printed literature, news media, and/or any other legal sources open and/or made available to the organization.
- (e) The corporation shall be empowered to establish child day-care centers, kindergarten, elementary, secondary schools and colleges.

#### B. POWERS

This corporation shall have all the powers, not contrary to law or to the statutes of the State of Florida, incident to or useful or necessary to carry out the purpose for which it is formed, subject, however, to the limitations, duties, and restrictions pertaining to a nonprofit corporation existing under the provisions of Chapter 617.01 Florida Statutes, and subject further to the limitations, duties and restrictions applicable to an organization qualified as exempt from federal income taxation within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as said statutes are now in force or may hereafter be amended. In furtherance of and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, it is expressly provided that this corporation shall also have the following powers:

- (a) To borrow money and give security therefor;
- (b) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose pertaining to its business, with any individual, entity, firm, association or corporation, private, public or municipal, or with any government or governmental, municipal or public authority, domestic or foreign;
- (c) To receive any gift, grant, contribution or devise and hold and use the same for the general purposes of any special purpose of this corporation; provided that gifts with conditions shall be accepted only if they are consistent with the purposes of a free public library;

- (d) To acquire from time to time for such uses and purposes, by purchase, gift, will or otherwise, real and personal property and to own, hold, control, administer, sell, exchange, mortgage or otherwise dispose of all or any part of such properties for the corporation and its membership, and/or assist where necessary, its autonomous and/or affiliated church organizations in similar pursuits, endeavors and undertakings;
- (e) To act as trustee of any funds or property that it may receive under specific or limited grants or agreements or under any will and to have and exercise the right to hold or manage such funds under the terms and conditions imposed by any such trust, grant, agreement or will;
- (f) To do everything necessary, convenient or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes of this corporation or which is calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the welfare or interest of this corporation;
- (g) To do any and all things in this article set forth to the same extent a natural person might or could do, in any part of the world, as principal, agent, contractor, trustee or otherwise either alone or in company with others.

#### C. LIMITATIONS

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law). Said limitations include, but are not restricted to, the requirement that no part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any private individual, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set fort; in the Articles of Incorporation; that no part of its activities shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; and that it shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

To the extent that this corporation should at any time be subject to Section 4941 through 4945 of the Internal Revenue

Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law), then this corporation:

- (a) Shall distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4952 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law);
- (b) Shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law);
- (c) Shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law);
- (d) Shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law);
- (e) Shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4954(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law).

#### ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

The officers of the corporation shall be President/Chief Executive Officer, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The affairs of the corporation will be managed by the incorporators. The names of the persons who are to serve as officers of the corporation are:

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public for office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Article III (A) (2), Section (e) is amended to delete the following:

kindergarten, elementary, secondary schools and colleges.

#### ARTICLE IX

Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.
