ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation :

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the corporation shall be : **THE NATIONAL ACADEMY FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND TRANSPORTATION, INC.**

 - (4) To make all contracts and do all things proper, incidental and conducive to the complete attainment of the foregoing purposes.
 - (5) This corporation is organized for educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.
