**ARTICLE I.  
NAME**

The name of this Corporation is ST. ANDREW'S FOUNDATION, INC.

**ARTICLE III  
GENERAL PURPOSE OF CORPORATION**

(a) To receive and administer funds for scientific, educational, and charitable purposes and to that end to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, grant, purchase, lease, or otherwise, either absolutely or jointly with any other person, persons, or corporation, any property, real, personal, tangible, or intangible, or any undivided interest therein, without limitation as to amount or value; to sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income thereof in such manner as, in the judgment of the directors, will best promote the purposes of the Corporation without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, this Certificate of Incorporation, the Bylaws of the Corporation, or any laws applicable thereto.

(b) In general, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all powers which it may now or hereafter be lawful for the Corporation to do or exercise under and pursuant

to the laws of the State of Florida for the purpose of accomplishing any of the purposes of the Corporation.

(c) The purposes for which the Corporation is organized shall be confined to those which are strictly scientific, educational, and charitable.

(d) The Corporation shall not engage nor shall any of its funds, property, or income be used in carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall the Corporation participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, nor shall the corporation engage in subversive or un-American activities.

(e) To operate without regard to race, creed, age, sex or natural origin.

(f) Except as otherwise limited by these Articles of Incorporation, to have and exercise all powers of any corporation not for profit as the same now exist, or may hereafter exist under the laws of the State of Florida. No part of the assets, income or profits of the Corporation shall be distributable to, or inure to the benefit of, its members, directors or officers or any private individual.

#### **ARTICLE IV. ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS**

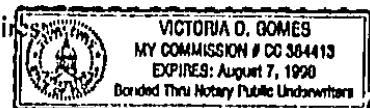


