Articles of Amendment

To The Articles of Incorporation

of

BHS REAL ESTATE FOUNDATION, INC. (a Not For Profit Corporation)

By majority vote of the Board of Directors and the Members of BHS Real Estate Foundation, Inc., at a meeting held on March 2/, 2002, at which a quorum was present, the Board of Directors and the Members adopted the following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation with such amendments to be effective as of March 25, 2002:
