ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION For

APHEC, International, Inc.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statues, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

APHEC, International, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPLE PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principle place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE(S)

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized are to:

Disseminate information and to educate in many forms (through music, role play, prints, media, street outreach). To promote health and help prevent diseases. To decrease the spread of HIV/AIDS and to prevent its transmission in the communities. To help build people's self esteem and provide them with support as they struggle to make informed and responsible lifestyle choices and decisions.

Educate the minority communities on disease prevention, especially HIV\AIDS and to further prevent the spread of the dreaded virus; help and encourage minorities to take precautionary actions today and not wait for tomorrow.

Emphasize education as much as possible, which is the necessary route to help stop the spread of diseases; network with other community based organizations, which will strengthen the collaborative effort to eliminate the spread of the HIV/AIDS epidemic; give a helping hand to those in need and to help better their living situations in every area; social, spiritual and physical.

Develop programs which will affect people's way of living, thus changing their behavior; address the issues of HIV/AIDS openly and clearly, thus climinating confusion. This will help decrease the fear of AIDS and help individuals talk about AIDS and its dangers and to disseminate information to minorities, especially those who are of African origin and who speak a language other than English.

Ensure proper multi-level communication - from those who are illiterate to those who are well educated; design special programs for youths which will assist in building their self-esteem, thus preserving the lives of the world's future leaders. Help bring the communities together and to improve the quality of life which will bring down the walls of discrimination against all in relation to the AIDS disease.

ARTICLE V - LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows:

ARTICLE VI

In the event of dissolution the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501 © (3) and 170 © (2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law or to the Federal, State or Local Government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE VII

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this Corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Sections 501 $\mathbb O$ (3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) a Corporation. Contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 $\mathbb O$ (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE VIII

Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purpose, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt, organizations under Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
