Enclosed please find a request for reinstatement of the above stated Non-Profit Corporation. Yesterday I spoke with someone in your office regarding our status and she advised me to forward the enclosed form and letter of explanation. We just discovered this week that our Corporation Status was INACTIVE. As briefly as possible I wish to address this situation.

Our former Secretary filed and mailed the 2001 Uniform Business Form (UBR) on April 21, 2001. On May 2, 2001, the form was returned but the check in the required amount of \$ 61.25 was cashed by the State. A copy of the check is enclosed for verification. Your records indicate the same. Our Secretary added the required Three (3) Directors and returned the UBR. The form was again rejected and returned to her for correction. The Secretary had lined through part of the corporation name by error. Again the UBR was returned. NOW.....the grey area.



Therefore, we respectfully request that the STATE waive the \$ 175.00 Non-Profit Reinstatement Fee. We are enclosing the \$ 61.25 Annual Report Fee and the \$ 8.75 Certificate of Status fee so that we will have proof in writing of our Status. We assure you that our Record Keeping shall be improved in the future.

We sincerely appreciate your time and apologize for our errors. We sincerely appreciate your assistance and will abide by and take further action if you so require.
