ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE HISPANIC CHURCH OF GOD (SEVENTH DAY), INC.

(a corporation not for profit)

WE, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purposed of forming a body corporate, under the laws of the State of Florida, and by and under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes providing for the information, liabilities, rights and immunities of a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be THE HISPANIC CHURCH OF GOD (SEVENTH DAY), INC. and the same shall be located on 113 South First Street, Haines City, Polk County, Florida.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES

The object of this association shall be for the purpose of diffusing religious knowledge and to promote the principles of morality, benevolence and charity; the education of mankind in general, and coordination of the work of THE HISPANIC CHURCH OF GOD (SEVENTH DAY), INC. in promoting the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The foregoing shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation. This corporation shall have, in addition, all powers, rights, and privileges conferred by the Constitution and the Laws of the State of Florida in respect to such corporations.

ARTICLE III QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS

Qualifications and admissions into this organization will be as follows: All members must confess and testify that they know the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. The members of this corporation shall be subscribers and such other persons as may from time to time be received into membership by the members of the corporation. Membership qualifications, induction,

responsibilities, and privileges will be those defined and specified in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE IV TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V SUBSCRIBERS

The names and addresses of the subscribers and incorporators are shown in Appendix A which is attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

ARTICLE VII TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees of the corporation will consist of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and one member elected by the membership. The number of Trustees may be increased or diminished from time to time, by the By-laws, adopted by the membership, but shall never be less than five. The term of the elected Trustee shall be prescribed by the By-laws.

ARTICLE VIII BY-LAWS

The By-laws of the corporation shall be made and adopted by the Trustees at a regular meeting thereof. Said By-Laws may be amended, altered or rescinded in accordance with said By-Laws.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENTS

The articles of incorporation may be amended, altered or rescinded by the Trustees by the presentation of the proposed amendment at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose and proposed by the Board of Trustees to the membership. The proposed amendment shall be approved and authorized by a vote of two-thirds majority, or more, of the members present and entitled to vote at a duly constituted meeting of the membership called for that purpose shall be necessary to amend the Articles of Incorporation. The same shall be operative from and after the date upon which said amendment shall be approved by the Secretary of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE X MISCELLANEOUS

Section I. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any individual or member.

Section II. No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of this corporation and upon dissolution of this organization all of its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to the General Conference of the

Church of God (Seventh Day) in Trust for subsequent use in the State of Florida for the purposes given in Article II or to any other organizations which have qualified for exemption under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal Government, or to a State or Local government, for a public purpose, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, officer or trustee of this corporation.
