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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED INCORPORATORS, by these Articles of Incorporation hereby form a Not-For-Profit Corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME

The name of this Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II - TERM OF CORPORATION

This corporation is formed to exist in perpetuity

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE OF THE CORPORATION

The Purpose of this Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation shall be:

- a) To promote education and social interaction between member Rabbis.
- b) To discuss issues of concern to members as religious leaders in the community.

c) To support and encourage members in respect to their professional capacities and development.

d) To bring member Rabbis together to work on common problems in the Jewish Community.

e) To promote Rabbinic participation in agencies of the Jewish and general communities.

f) To serve as the Rabbinic voice on Jewish and communal issues.

g) To conduct any and all activities allowed or permissible by the laws of Florida or the United States.

ARTICLE IV - NOT-FOR-PROFIT STATUS

This Corporation shall issue no stock. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under § 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision

of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or by a Corporation contributions to which are deductible under § 170 (c)(2) of the Internal revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. On the dissolution of this corporation the Board of Directors shall dispose of all of the assets of this Corporation exclusively for the purposes of this Corporation in the manner or to the organization or organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes and that shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under § 501 (c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of the corporation is then located exclusively for the purposes or to the organizations that the court determines are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes.

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

The Broward Board of rabbis will be open to all properly ordained Rabbis who live in and/or work inside the boundaries of Broward County, Florida. It shall also be open to properly ordained Rabbis who may live and work outside Broward County but have legitimate reasons to wish to belong.



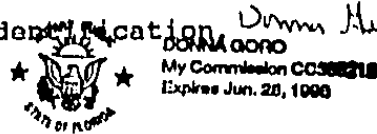
