To whom it may concern:

Enclosed please find an application for reinstatement for the Monroe Council of the Arts Corporation, Articles of Incorporation filed February 17, 1997. Enclosed also is a check for \$306.25 for filing fees and a certificate of status. Please change the mailing address as noted.

We received no renewal mailings. Application instructions state that annual reports will be mailed to the last known mailing address. This address, PO Box 717, was provided when bylaw amendments were filed December 16, 1997 and correspondence went back and forth between that address and your office repeatedly.

The Division of Cultural Affairs discovered the dissolution in a review of our corporate status. We now risk losing vital grant monies due to our ineligibility status.

Can you provide a letter recommending the Division of Cultural Affairs consider us eligible for funding since the failure to file was unintentional, due solely to not receiving renewal mailings?

A volunteer board of directors established the Monroe Council of the Arts. Apparently, the address (PO Box 1321) used in the original Articles of Incorporation belonged to a board member or volunteer no longer associated with the organization. It would seem that mail sent to that address would be returned to you. We've struggled to build a viable local arts agency up from the ashes of the previous organization, and have been commended for doing so. It would be devastating to lose funding, and even worse to have to return funds previously awarded.

In addition to filing the amendments, we have filed and renewed as appropriate with the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs, Florida Dept. of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Florida Department of Revenue, IRS (941 and 990), U.S. Postal Service Bulk Mail, City of Key West occupational license, and Monroe County Occupational license.

Thank you for your help with this matter.
