#### NORTH FLORIDA VETERANS RESEARCH CORPORATION, INC.

#### First Amendment-December 1997

The Board of Directors of the North Florida Veterans Research Corporation, Inc. adopted a resolution setting forth the following proposed amendments and directed that they be submitted to a vote at a special meeting of Members entitled to vote on the proposed amendments. Prior written notice setting for the proposed amendments was given to each member entitled to vote at such meeting in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws.

The following text of the proposed amendments were adopted by a majority of the members of the North Florida Veterans Research Corporation, Inc. In accordance with provisions set forth in the corporate bylaws, on April 18, 1997.

## Article III <u>Purposes</u>

Article III (a)-To advance medical research in the Department of Veterans Affairs, including investigations, experiments and studies to discover, develop or verify knowledge relating to the causes, diagnosis, treatment or control of physical or mental diseases and impairments of mankind, in conjunction with the Veterans Affairs Medical Center, 801 South Marion Street, Lake City, Florida 32025-5898; and

Article III (d)-No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## Article V <u>Limitation of Corporate Powers</u>

Article V(a)-Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

## Article IX <u>Dissolution</u>

Article IX-Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
