FLORIDA WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE GUARANTY ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED (a Florida not for profit corporation)

AND

FLORIDA SELF-INSURANCE FUND GUARANTY ASSOCIATION, INC. (a Florida not for profit corporation)

Pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, these Articles of Merger provide that:

- 1. The Florida Self-Insurance Fund Guaranty Association, Inc. ("FSIFGA"), a Florida not for profit corporation, shall be merged with and into the Florida Workers' Compensation Insurance Guaranty Association, Incorporated ("FWCIGA"), a Florida not for profit corporation, which shall be the surviving corporation. (The FWCIGA and FSIFGA are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Constituent Corporations").
- 2. The members of the Constituent Corporations are not entitled to vote on a Plan of Merger. The Agreement and Plan of Merger between Florida Workers' Compensation Insurance Guaranty Association, Incorporated and Florida Self Insurance Fund Guaranty Association, Inc. (the "Plan") was adopted by the Interim Board of Directors of the FWCIGA on August 15, 1997, and was adopted by the Board of Directors of the FSIFGA on September 10, 1997. At the time the Plan was adopted by the Interim Board of Directors of the FWCIGA, eleven (11) directors then held office, and the Plan was unanimously adopted by its Board of Directors. At the time the Plan was adopted by the Board of Directors of the FSIFGA, eight (8) directors then held office, and the Plan was unanimously adopted by its Board of Directors.

3. The Merger shall become effective as of 12:01 a.m. (EDT), October 1, 1997.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, these Articles of Merger have been executed on behalf of the Constituent Corporations by their authorized chairmen as of October 1, 1997.

AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER

BETWEEN

FLORIDA WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE GUARANTY ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED (a Florida not for profit corporation)

AND

FLORIDA SELF-INSURANCE FUND GUARANTY ASSOCIATION, INC. (a Florida not for profit corporation)

THIS AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER is made and entered into this <u>29</u>th day of September, 1997, between the Florida Workers' Compensation Insurance Guaranty Association, Incorporated, a Florida not for profit corporation ("FWCIGA"), and the Florida Self-Insurance Fund Guaranty Association, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation ("FSIFGA").

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants set forth in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1. In accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, the Florida Workers' Compensation Insurance Guaranty Association Act, and the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, at the Effective Time (as defined below), the FSIFGA shall be merged with and into the FWCIGA (the "Merger"), the separate and corporate existence of the FSIFGA shall cease, and the FWCIGA (the "Surviving Corporation") shall continue its corporate existence pursuant to the laws of Florida under its present name. (The FWCIGA and the FSIFGA are collectively referred to as the "Constituent Corporations").

- 2. The Merger shall become effective as of 12:01 a.m. (EDT), October 1, 1997 (the "Effective Time").
- 3. The Surviving Corporation shall possess and retain every interest in all assets and property of every description of each of the Constituent Corporations. The rights, privileges, immunities, powers, franchises, and authority, of a public, as well as private, nature of each of the Constituent Corporations shall be vested in the Surviving Corporation without further act or deed. The title to any interest in all real estate vested in either of the Constituent Corporations shall not revert or in any way be impaired by reason of the Merger.
- 4. All obligations belonging to or due to each of the Constituent Corporations shall be vested in the Surviving Corporation without further act or deed, and the Surviving Corporation shall be liable for all of the obligations of each of the Constituent Corporations existing as of the Effective Time.
- The articles of incorporation of the FWCIGA in effect immediately prior to the Effective Time shall continue without change and be the articles of incorporation of the Surviving Corporation.
- 6. This document may be executed in one or more counterparts, a complete set of which shall constitute one original.
- 7. All terms, covenants and conditions of this Agreement are set forth herein and there are no warranties, agreements, or understandings, expressed or implied, except as are expressly set forth herein. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties hereto and supersedes any prior agreement or understanding relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.

- 8. This Agreement may be modified or amended only by a written instrument executed and signed by both parties.
- 9. This Agreement was executed and delivered in the state of Florida and all obligations hereunder shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
