THE ARTICLES of INCORPORATION of the MANNE du CIEL OUTREACH MINISTRIES, INC.

The undersigned incorporator to these articles of incorporation hereby forms a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be the MANNE du CIEL OUTREACH MINISTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE II TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This corporation is formed for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful purposes which are not for pecuniary profit including providing ministerial, social and educational services.

ARTICLE V THE EARNINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF CORPORATION

(a) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office including the publishing or distribution of statements.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision of payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes and shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VII REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The address of the registered office of the corporation shall be in care of Dieuseul Saint Jean, 770 Northwest 37th Street, Oakland Park, Florida 33309. The registered agent of this corporation shall be Dieuseul Saint Jean. THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE ADDRESS IS SAME AS REGISTERED OFFICE ADDRESS.


