# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

#### PREAMBLE

TALLAMASSEL, FLORIDA

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves under the following Articles, for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be:

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

## ARTICLE III GENERAL NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation is:

- (1) This Association is formed to advance the science of jurisprudence, to promote reform in the law, to facilitate the administration of justice, to uphold the highest standard of integrity, learning, honor and courtesy in the legal profession, including lawyers and judges alike, to cultivate a spirit of cordiality and brotherhood among the members of the Bar and between them and the Bench, and to purchase, own and maintain a general law library or the advantages thereof for the use and benefit of the members of the Association.

The territory in which the operations of the Corporation are to be conducted is the State of Florida of the United States of America.

#### ARTICLE VI TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall exist perpetually.
