

## Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of the Telugu Association of Florida Inc (TAF)

Article VI is deleted and replaced by

## ARTICLE VI MEMBERS, EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND MANNER OF ELECTIONS

- 1. **Qualifications**: Any person interested and believing in the objectives stated in Article Ill of the Articles shall be eligible for membership.
- 2. Admission to membership: Admission to membership shall be upon approval by the majority of the Executive Committee after reviewing the application submitted by the prospective member and upon the payment of the dues as determined by the Executive Committee from time to time. Any member who has not paid the dues and /or found to be delinquent by the terms of membership agreement shall lose his or her membership, rights and privileges.

## 3. The Executive Committee:

- a. The Corporation shall be governed by the Executive Committee consisting of at least five (5) members, but not more than eleven (11) members, called Coordinators. A Coordinator shall be a member of good standing of the Association (TAF) for at least four (4) immediate preceding years.
- b. The Executive Committee shall consist of two (2) classes of Coordinators.
  - 1. Founding Coordinators, and
  - 2. Administrative Coordinators

#### **c.1** Founding Coordinators

c.2 Founding Coordinators shall act as a senior body and shall oversee that the decisions and actions taken are in consonance with the goals and objectives of the Association. There shall be no time limit for the term in Office for the Founding Coordinators.

## d. Administrative Coordinators:

Administrative Coordinators shall be appointed by the majority vote of the Founding Coordinators. The term of office for each Administrative Coordinator shall be two (2) years and /or until the successor is duly Appointed by the Founding Coordinators and qualified.

In Article VII, section 2 (Election and Term of Office) is deleted and replaced by

2. Election and Term of Office: The Executive committee shall elect Officers at each Annual Meeting of the Committee and may at any meeting, fill any officer vacancy. No Officer shall serve for more than two (2) consecutive years in his or her office.
