ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

C. SEE FISA HARLEY OWNERS GROUP®--SPACE COAST CHAPTER, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, being a natural person competent to contract, hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation in order to form a not-for-profit corporation without stock under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation is Harley Owners Group®--Space Coast Chapter, Inc.

ARTICLE II

This Corporation shall commence upon the execution of these Articles and shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III
