ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION SECRETARY OF STATE LITERACY VOLUNTEERS OF GADSDEN COUNTY, INC. TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA (A nonprofit corporation)

ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation shall be "Literacy Volunteers of Gadsden County, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The address of the office and the mailing address of the corporation is:

ARTICLE III Purposes

The purpose of the organization is to promote and foster increased literacy in Gadsden County, Florida and contiguous areas through volunteer teaching of and aid to the illiterate and semi-literate; to encourage and aid individuals, groups or organizations desiring to increase literacy through voluntary programs; to receive, invest and disburse funds; and to hold property for the purposes of the organization.

The purposes and powers of this corporation are limited to those meeting the requirements for exemption under 26 U.S.C s. 501 (c) (3), as may be amended from time to time, including corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE IV Manner of Election of Directors

The business affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of directors. The number of directors shall be set forth in the by-laws but shall never be less than three. The directors shall be members of the corporation. Members of the board of directors shall be elected and shall hold office in accordance with the by-laws.

ARTICLE V Limitation of Corporate Powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except:

This corporation shall have no capital stock, its objective and purpose being solely of a charitable, literary and educational character and not for individual pecuniary gain or profits to its members. This shall not prohibit payment to individuals for services received or assets purchased. The property, assets, profits, and net income of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the profits, assets, or net income of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, member, or any private shareholder or individual.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets, if any, remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to Literacy Volunteers of Florida or to such similar non-profit charitable organization as may be selected by the board of directors and which must be organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and is a tax-exempt organization pursuant to 26 U.S.C. s. 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and no part of its activities

shall consist of intervening, including the publishing and distribution of statements, in any political campaign in behalf of any candidate for public office.

No director, officer, or member of this corporation shall be subject to assessment by the corporation except for such dues as may be provided for in the by-laws, nor shall any such director, officer, or member be personally liable for any of the debts, liabilities, obligations, or undertakings of the corporation. All of the liabilities of the corporation shall be limited to its common funds and assets.

This corporation operates as a local affiliate of Literacy Volunteers of America, Inc., an organization tax exempt under 26 U.S.C. s. 501 (c)(3).
