Articles of Incorporation of High Point Community Pride, Inc.

The undersigned hereby associate themselves to form a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, and, for these purposes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I Name

The name of the corporation is: High Point Community Pride, Inc.

Article II Address

Article III Purposes

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To provide an opportunity for individuals to serve in cooperative programs and relationships with the people in the High Point Community.
- B. To initiate and support neighborhood development projects which include but are <u>not limited</u> to compassionate ministry for the needy, education, health services, recreational services, legal aid, counseling services and opportunities for youth.
- C. To promote the health and safety, communication, environmental awareness and resources of the residents of High Point.
- D. To provide and refer to the residents of High Point resources in regards to issues of conflict.
- E. To engage in fund raising activities for the benefit of the community.

- F. To recognize the need for people to be involved in a process which gives them the opportunity to work toward the solution of their own personal (with respect to privacy) and community problems.
- G. To provide a structure through which government and private organizations can channel their material and personal resources into the development of projects which serve people who live in the community.
- H. In general, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all powers which now or hereafter are lawful for the corporation to do or exercise under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida for the purpose of accomplishing any of the purposes of the corporation.

The purpose for which this corporation is organized shall be limited to that which is strictly charitable. In no event shall this corporation engage in any activity which would be contrary to purposes and activities permitted to be engaged in by any organization the activities of which are exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as hereafter amended, and the applicable rules and regulations thereunder.

The corporation shall not engage, nor shall any of its funds, property, or income be used, in carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall the corporation participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any

candidate for public office, nor shall the corporation engage in subversive activities.

I. High Point Community Pride, Inc. shall adopt the intent of the Government in the Sunshine Law, by having open meetings, notification of meetings to all community residents, open discussion and decision making at all meetings, with policy making being decided by a majority.

Article IV Members

The qualifications of members and the manner of admission of members shall be as specified in the bylaws of the Corporation.

<u>Article V</u> <u>Limitation of Corporate Powers</u>

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited are as follows: In terms of compensation, directors shall not receive any stated salaries for their services, but a reasonable amount may be allowed for reimbursement of expenses incurred in attending to their authorized duties, including but not limited to, their attendance at meetings and seminars.

In regard to subsections (7), (11), (12) and (16), there must be a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
