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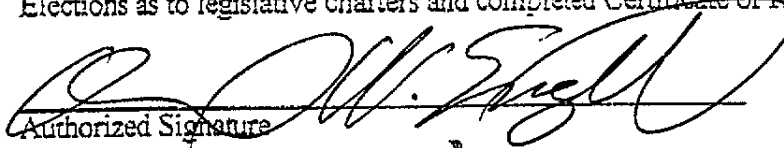

CERTIFICATE OF REINCORPORATION

Pursuant to §617.0901, Florida Statutes, this certificate of reincorporation was duly authorized by a meeting of its members regularly called or by a meeting of its board of directors if there were no members entitled to vote on the reincorporation:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: CORAL BAPTIST CHURCH OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 2732 S.W. 32 Avenue, Miami, FL 33133.

ARTICLE III
PURPOSES

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is: To conduct religious worship and instruction churches, schools, parsonages and other institutions connected therewith of a religious, educational, charitable and benevolent character to the end that its own members and others may be generally instructed and guided concerning those articles of faith which are most surely held among Southern Missionary Baptist Churches and to advance spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and personal purity among its own membership and the people of the community in which it is located; to promote home and foreign missions; and to aid in the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth; also to educate, prepare and ordain Christian men and women for the ministry of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

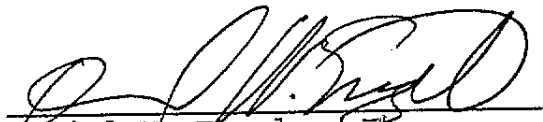

CHARTER OF
CORAL BAPTIST CHURCH
OF MIAMI, FLORIDA

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE ELEVENTH
JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA, IN AND FOR DADE COUNTY.

WE, the undersigned, hereby associate
ourselves together for the purpose of becoming
incorporated under the laws of the State of
Florida, applicable to corporations not for
profit, under the following proposed Charter:

ARTICLE I. - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be "CORAL BAPTIST
CHURCH OF MIAMI, FLORIDA", and it is to be located in Miami,
Dade County, Florida.

ARTICLE II. - OBJECT

The general nature of the object of this corporation
is to conduct for religious worship and instruction churches,
schools, parsonages, and other institutions connected therewith
of a religious, educational, charitable and benevolent character
to the end that its own members and others may be generally in-
structed and guided concerning those articles of faith which
are most surely held among Southern Missionary Baptist Churches
and to advance spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and
personal purity among its own membership and the people of the
community in which it is located; to promote home and foreign
missions; and to aid in the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ
to the ends of the earth; also to educate, prepare, and ordain
Christian men and women for the ministry of the Gospel of
Jesus Christ.

ARTICLE III. - MEMBERSHIP

Every person who believes in repentance toward God, and faith in Jesus Christ, as Saviour and Lord, and who is willing to confess Him publicly as Lord and King and follow Him in baptism by immersion, and to observe the ordinances of Christ and to be governed by His Laws, is qualified and eligible for membership in this corporation. The manner of admission to membership in said corporation shall be by letter of dismission from other churches of like faith and order and by satisfactory statement of former membership in a Missionary Baptist Church, and profession of faith as hereinbefore provided, upon a favorable majority vote of the membership of said corporation present at any meeting of said Church. The present membership of the Coral Baptist Church of Miami, Florida (unincorporated) and those hereafter admitted to such membership shall constitute the membership of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV. - TERM

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V. - SUBSCRIBERS

ARTICLE VI. - OFFICERS

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Deacons, such management to be subject to the approval of the Church, and said Board to be composed of not less than five and said Board of Deacons shall be elected from and by the membership of said corporation. The term of membership of Deacons shall be for life, or for such other length of time, not less than one year, as the membership of said corporation may provide by its by-laws. The said Board of Deacons shall appoint from its own membership a Chairman and Secretary. All elections to membership on said Board of Deacons shall be by a majority vote of the members of said corporation present at any business meeting of the said corporation.

The present Board of Deacons of the Coral Baptist Church of Miami, Florida, the Incorporators hereof, and whose names are set forth hereinabove in Article V, shall constitute the Board of Deacons and shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified.

In addition to said Board of Deacons said corporation shall have a Pastor, Church Clerk, Treasurer, and such other officers as may be necessary, and such officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the corporation present at any business meeting of said corporation for such term as the corporation may provide by its by-laws.

ARTICLE VII. - FIRST OFFICERS

ARTICLE VIII. - BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of the corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded upon a two-thirds vote of the members present at any annual meeting of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX. - INDEBTEDNESS

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may, at any time subject itself, which shall never be greater than two-thirds of the value of the property of the corporation, shall be FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000.00).

ARTICLE X. - VALUE OF REAL ESTATE

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold, subject always to the approval of the Circuit Judge, shall be SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000.00).
