ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation for religious purposes, and under the provisions of Chapter 617, of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of this corporation is TEMPLE OF GRACE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH, INC. and the principal office shall be 5797 NW 185th Street, Orange Lake, Florida 32681.

ARTICLE II - Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are as follows:

The general nature of the object of this corporation is to promote the message of Jesus Christ through the Bible which is the Word of God, and to bring encouragement and exhortation to the Body of Christ Jesus; and to exercise any and all rights and privileges which are now or which may hereafter be conferred upon corporations organized pursuant to the non-profit corporation laws of the State of Florida, within the limitations of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or any corresponding provision of future provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE X

- 1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.
- 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.
- 4. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation,

dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or of the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of in such manner as approved by order of the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office is located, upon petition therefor by the Board of Trustees, and after the publication of such notice as the Court may direct.
