AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL SEAFARERS' MISSION OF TAMPA BAY, INC.

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation (the "Corporation") is The International Seafarers' Mission of Tampa Bay, Inc.

ARTICLE II Not For Profit

The Corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person.

ARTICLE III Purpose

The purpose of the Corporation is to promote and safeguard the physical, mental, spiritual and emotional well being of men and women, who serve as crews and port workers at the sea and air ports of Tampa, including, but not limited to, those that work on cargo and cruise ships at the ports of Tampa, Florida, and those who may provide services to the air ports of Tampa regardless of race, creed, color, nationality, gender or religious affiliation.

The Corporation intends to accomplish its purpose through the following activities:

- (1) Serving the needs of the seafarers and workers at the ports of Tampa by providing one or more centers where they can rest physically and spiritually.
- (2) Providing access to welfare services of the country of origin of seafarers and workers at the ports of Tampa, where feasible and possible.
- (3) Providing access, where possible, to benefits such as medical insurance, optical insurance, dental insurance, counseling (drug & alcohol abuse, pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases, terminal illness, adoption), and other physical and mental health assistance for scafarers and workers at the ports of Tampa.
- (4) Providing venues where religious services can be obtained regardless of the religious affiliation of the individual.
- (5) Providing assistance in cases of duress or emergency when members die or become incapacitated in ports away from home or when family members die.

- (8) Collaborating and cooperating with other local, state and out-of-state Seafarer Ministries that provide similar services and serve similar purposes.
- (b) The corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.

Any such assets not so disposed of within ninety (90) days following such dissolution shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes and to such organizations described in the preceding sentence.

ARTICLE X Amendment

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision contained in these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereinafter prescribed by the laws of the State of Florida. All rights, powers, privilege, and discretionary authority granted or confessed herein upon the Directors are granted or confessed subject to this reservation.
