ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of  
EASTWOOD MARINE CANVAS, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby declares his intention to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is Eastwood Marine Canvas, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted by the corporation shall be to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida and any lawful activity whatsoever.

The corporation shall have and exercise all powers, without limitation, conferred by the laws of the State of Florida now in force and which may hereafter be enacted.

ARTICLE III

The total shares of capital stock authorized to be outstanding at any one time by this corporation is 10 shares, all common stock, of the par value of \$10.00 each. 
