ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of ESPERANZA DOLLAR STORE, INC.

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SECRETARY OF STAIL

I, the undersigned incorporator of this corporation under Florida Statutes 1697, Eas LORIDA amended, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is Esperanza Dollar Store, Inc. The principal place of business and address is 4768 SW 6th Street, Miami, FL 33134.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES
